Nestled in the very heart of the Colombian port city, Casa Pombo is a stone's throw away from some of Latin America's most beloved landmarks and cultural institutions, from the Governor's Palace to Cartagena's Cathedral.

The imperial history of this majestic colonial mansion dating back to the 16th century is exquisitely preserved by Casa Pombo, wonderfully capturing the vibrancy of the culture. Original Hispano-Arabesque columns line the luscious veranda, the authentic masonry abounding in classical beauty next to rustic wooden flourishes. Vaulted and exposed beam ceilings exceed up to sixteen feet in height, maintaining an incredible sense of verticality throughout. Floating staircases and contemporary furnishings meld seamlessly with original nude stone walls, curating a one-of-a-kind mixture of old-world refinement and industrial-chic grit. Across 15,000 sq. ft. of extreme architectural detail lies fourteen bedrooms, most equipped with private balconies and terraces. Pombo's rooftop mirador towers over commands exceptional views over lush tropical foliage, the inner courtyard, and the enthralling old town of Cartagena.

Casa Pombo is a remarkable estate that has exceeded its reputation as a former colonial mansion, courtesy of world-recognized restorationist Alvaro Barrera. The internal patio pool provides a fabulously serene oasis, immaculately conceived with deck space, a walkway, and a waterfall feature flush with greenery. A rooftop swimming pool with solarium completes this Central American dream property.


